The Nova Scotian Institute of Science (NSIS), in collaboration with the Situating Science Knowledge Cluster (Halifax), is sponsoring the NSIS 2013 Science Writing Competition. Prizes will be awarded in two categories:

\$500 for the best article written by a Graduate

\$250 for the best article written by an Undergraduate

The work of the winners will be featured on the NSIS and Situating Science Knowledge Cluster websites. The author of the winning paper will also be invited to submit the paper for publication in the *Proceedings of the Nova Scotian Institute of Science*.
